# Appeal Case to the Information Commission, Seychelles

# Statement of Recommendations, Findings, Orders, Decisions and Directives as per Part VII, Section 64

## Scope of the Case

- 1. The requestor, Mr. Marco Francis, appealed to the Commission on September 14<sup>th</sup> 2020, about the Department of Immigration and Civil Status's failure to respond to his request.
- 2. The Commission has considered whether the Department of Immigration has complied with its obligations in relation to the Right of Access at Section 8 and the response to a request at Section 11(1) of the ATIA.

## **Request and Response**

- 3. On July 22<sup>nd</sup> 2020, the requestor wrote to the Information Officer and requested information in the following terms:
  - 3.1 Requesting further access to information in the case of Mr. Varsani because he has been declared a prohibited immigrant under the section of the Immigration Decree.
- 4. On August 10<sup>th</sup> 2020, The Information Officer acknowledge and provide a reply that he confirm that Mr. Varsani has been declared a prohibited immigrant under section 19 (1) h (ii). Further informed the requestor to apply for a review with the Head of Information Holder of Immigration and Civil status.
- 5. The requestor made a review to the Head of Information Holder on August 21<sup>st</sup> 2020.
- 6. The Head of Information Holder failed to give a decision on the review application as per Section 35 (1).

#### Orders

- 7. On September 16<sup>th</sup> 2020, the Commission ordered the Head of Information Holder of the Department of Immigration and Civil Status to provide a right of reply to the requestor in 7 days.
- On October 12<sup>th</sup> 2020, pursuant to 63 (3), a summons was sent to the Head of Information Holder to appear before the Information Commission on November 4<sup>th</sup>, 2020. After no reply from the Head of Information Holder was received.
- 9. On November 4<sup>th</sup> 2020 if the Head of Information Holder failed to attend the hearing, a second and final summons was sent for November 12<sup>th</sup> 2020.

## Directives

10. Pursuant to Section 63 (1)(d) and in conjunction with Section 48 (4)(a to e) of the Access to Information Act, 2018 Commission ordered to provide the Information requested.

#### Decision (including any steps ordered)

- 11. The release of Information was completed on November 19<sup>th</sup> 2020. No further steps required.
- 12. The case closed on November 19<sup>th</sup> 2020.

#### **Reasons for Decision**

- 13. Section 8 of ATIA states that: "subject of this Act, every person has a right to access to information from a public body is the case"
- 14. Section 11(1) of ATIA states that: "Subject of subsection (2), the Information Officer to whom a request is made under section 9 shall, as soon as reasonably possible, but in any event within 21 days after the request is submitted
  - (a) Determine whether to grant the request;
  - (b) Notify the requestor of the decision in writing.
